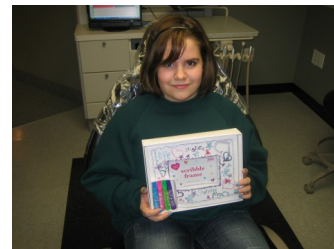

Tooth Whitening 101

There are several ways to improve the look of your smile. Bleaching products contain peroxide which actually bleach the tooth enamel. These products typically rely on carbamide peroxide as the bleaching agent. The peroxide gel comes in different concentrations. Our office uses 10%, 22%, and 35%. "Whitening toothpastes" remove surface stains through the action of mild abrasives. Unlike bleach, toothpaste does not alter the intrinsic color of the teeth.

In office bleaching

During chairside bleaching, the bleaching agent is applied to the teeth for 30 minutes. A special light is then used to enhance the action of the agent. This form of whitening uses a higher concentration of bleaching gel. Results are achieved immediately.

At home bleaching

The bleaching gel is placed in a custom made tray. Results are usually achieved in 2 weeks.



The most common side effects of tooth whitening is sensitivity and soft tissue irritation. Tooth sensitivity is usually temporary and should lessen once the treatment is complete. Some patients also experience soft tissue irritation if the solution comes in contact with the gums.
