

What Is A Crown?

A crown (or cap) is a covering that encases the entire tooth surface restoring it to its original shape and size or even creating a more harmonious result whose color, shape and size yield a more pleasing appearance. A crown protects and strengthens tooth structure that cannot be restored with fillings or other types of restorations.

Although there are several types of crowns, tooth colored crowns, are the most popular,

because they resemble your natural teeth. They can be made of all porcelain, porcelain fused to metal or totally ceramic. They are highly durable and will last many years, but like most dental restorations, they may eventually need to be replaced. Porcelain crowns are made to match the shape, size, and color of your teeth giving you a natural, long-lasting beautiful smile.
